This group meets every Tuesday afternoon 1 - 4pm in the Village Hall.

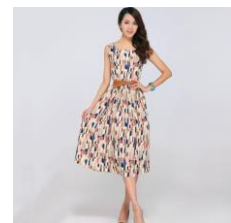

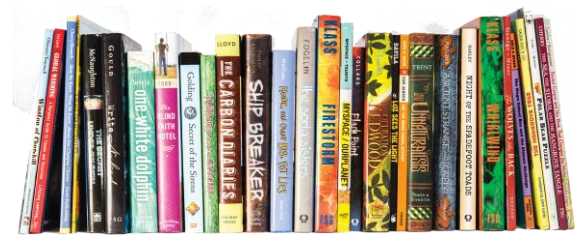
